_____ After inquiry, the Court finds that the defendant understands his/her guilty plea and the consequences thereof; has read or discussed with his/her attorney and signed the guilty plea form and understands the contents of the same; knowingly, voluntarily and intelligently waives his/her right to trial; and he/she knowingly, voluntarily and intelligently enters his/her plea. Defendant pleads guilty and a factual basis is established.

_____ The defendant has read or discussed with his/her attorney the Notice and Waiver of Right to Appeal and Right to Seek Post-Conviction Relief form and the Notice and Waiver of Indigency Status form required by the District Attorney as a condition of the negotiated plea. After examination, the Court determines that the defendant has knowingly, voluntarily and intelligently signed such documents for the purpose of receiving the benefits of this negotiated sentence recommendation.

_____ Upon the defendant's plea of guilty, the Court accepts the plea and adjudges the defendant guilty of being a youthful offender.

_____ Upon the defendant's plea of guilty, the Court accepts the plea and adjudges the defendant guilty of _____.

_____ Upon motion of the State, Count(s) _____ of the indictment or Case Number _____ is/are DISMISSED.

_____ The defendant makes application for probation; the defendant waives applying for probation and the court finds the waiver to be made knowingly, intelligently and voluntarily.

_____ Sentencing/probation hearing is set before the Court on _____.

_____ Sentencing is deferred, and the probation office shall perform a pre-sentence investigation and furnish the Court and the attorneys as soon as practicable with: a presentence report; a voluntary sentencing standards worksheet (if applicable).

_____ Sentencing proceeds without objection, and the defendant is sentenced as recorded in the Sentencing Order simultaneously entered herewith.
