

Petition for Relief from the Requirements of the Alabama Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Act

Comes now the Petitioner, _____, pursuant to § 15-20A-24, Ala. Code 1975 of the Alabama Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Act ("the Act"), and petitions this court for relief from the requirements set forth in the Act. The petitioner asserts to the following:

1. That the Petitioner was charged with _____ and adjudicated delinquent of _____, (a) sex offense(s) in _____ case numbers:

2. That the sex offense did not involve force and was only a crime due to the age of the victim; at the time of the commission of the sex offense, the victim was 13 years of age or older; and at the time of the commission of the sex offense, the Petitioner was less than five years older than the victim.
3. That the Petitioner files contemporaneously with this petition the following supporting documentation:
 - a. A certified copy of the adjudication requiring registration which includes a detailed description of the sex offense (if the petition is filed upon completion of probation or a term of registration);
 - b. Proof of the age of the victim and the age of the sex offender at the time of the commission of the sex offense;
 - c. A list of each agency with whom the Petitioner is required to register or has ever been required to register as a sex offender (if the petition is filed upon completion of probation or a term of registration);
 - d. A copy of the Petitioner's criminal record;
 - e. An affidavit of the Petitioner stating that the Petitioner has no pending criminal charges; and
 - f. Any other information requested by the court.

The Petitioner shall serve a copy of this petition by certified mail on all of the following: (1) The prosecuting attorney in the county of adjudication if the Petitioner was adjudicated in this state; (2) The prosecuting attorney of the county where the Petitioner resides; and (3) Local law enforcement where the Petitioner was adjudicated if the Petitioner was adjudicated in this state.

Failure of the Petitioner to serve a copy of the petition shall result in an automatic denial of the petition. Also, knowingly providing false or misleading information in this petition could result in being charged with a Class C felony.
