- 3. Restitution collection programs.
- 4. Community service work programs.
- 5. Programs utilizing trained volunteers including mentor programs, volunteers in probation, and other programs.
- 6. Programs mandating parental accountability.
- 7. Intensive aftercare programs for children returning from regional or state institutions.
