## **Standard License or ID Temporary Permit for Adult Sex Offenders**

The Alabama Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Act<sup>1</sup> ("Act") requires adult sex offenders to obtain a valid driver license or identification card issued by the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency ("ALEA") with a designation that enables law enforcement to identify the licensee as a Sex Offender within fourteen (14) days of registration. This form allows an adult sex offender to carry his or her non-designated license or identification card for thirty (30) days from the *Date of Issuance* listed below if the offender's information is not yet entered into the State Sex Offender Registry.

At the expiration of this time period, I understand I am required to return to the driver license office to obtain a driver license or identification card with the sex offender designation placed on it. At this time, I understand that I am to relinquish, to ALEA, any other driver license(s) or identification card(s) previously issued to me by a state motor vehicle agency which do not bear any designation enabling law enforcement officers to identify me as a sex offender.
